Privacy Statement pursuant to Article 13, Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003.

In compliance with Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003 (Privacy Code) and subsequent amendments, we hereby provide you with the information required concerning the processing of personal data provided for the provision of the liberal contribution to the Fondazione la Triennale di Milano. This privacy statement is pursuant to Article 13 of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 - Personal Data Protection Code.

1. The "DATA CONTROLLER", in compliance with Article 28 of the Personal Data Protection Code, is the Fondazione La Triennale di Milano, Viale Alemagna 6, 20121 Milan, acting through its pro-tempore legal representative.

The DATA PROCESSING MANAGER: in compliance with Article 29 of the Personal Data Protection Code, the internal Data Processing Manager is the Public Services and Research Office, c/o the Data Controller.

2. TYPES OF DATA UNDERGOING PROCESSING.

Personal and identification data. Personal data, any information regarding the natural person, identified or identifiable, including information collected indirectly via reference to any other information, including a personal identification number; Identification data, personal data that permit direct identification of the data subject (e.g. first name, surname, date of birth, address, e-mail address, telephone number, etc.).

3. PURPOSES OF PERSONAL DATA PROCESSING FOR WHICH CONSENT IS GRANTED WHEN REQUESTED (ARTICLE 23 of LEGISLATIVE DECREE no. 196/03).

A) To make provision for the informative, administrative, commercial and accounting obligations related to the management of your 'Contemporaneamente Italia' card (including recording your registration with the Project, sending you reminders regarding the card expiry date and the opportunity to renew it, etc.);

Upon consent and until your refusal:

B) To send, from the Public Services and Research Office of the Fondazione La Triennale di Milano, promotional communication regarding activities/products/services offered by the Museums and by the Partners of the 'Contemporaneamente Italia' Project, via e-mail, SMS messages, phone calls and printed mail;

C) To send, from the individual Museums and by the Partners of the Project, promotional communication regarding activities/products/services via e-mail, SMS messages, phone calls and printed mail; To request the Privacy document pursuant to Article 13 and to exercise the rights of the data subject (Articles 7 to 10) of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003, for subsequent data processing by individual Partners of the Project, the data subject is required to contact the third party – an independent data controller - who will send promotional communications.

4. PROCESSING METHODS - DATA RETENTION

Processing will be carried out by automated and/or manual means, using procedures and tools intended to guarantee the utmost security and confidentiality, by persons specifically appointed in compliance with the provisions of Articles 31 and subsequent amendments of Legislative Decree no. 196/03. Data will be retained for a period that does not exceed the purposes for which the data were collected and subsequently processed.

5. SCOPE OF DATA COMMUNICATION AND DISCLOSURE

With prior consent, your personal data will be disclosed for the purposes and within the limits outlined in this privacy statement. Your personal data may be communicated to third-party companies connected and/or contractually linked to the Fondazione La Triennale di Milano: - entities that provide management services for the activities mentioned above in the purposes section (e.g. press agencies, communication contacts, managers of content upload on websites, platform managers, website hosting managers); - offices or companies offering assistance and consultancy, etc.); - competent authorities in order to comply with legal obligations and/or provisions of public bodies, on request. Persons belonging to the aforesaid categories carry out their work as Data Processing Managers or work entirely independently as Data Controllers. The list of appointed Data Processing Managers is constantly updated and available at the main offices of the Fondazione La Triennale di Milano.

6. NATURE OF DATA PROVISION AND REFUSAL

The provision of personal data is required in order to participate in the project (Purpose A). Failure to provide such data will make it impossible for you to take part in the programme. The provision of personal data is optional for purposes B) and C). Failure to provide such data will still entitle you to purchase the 'Contemporaneamente Italia' card.

7. DATA SUBJECT RIGHTS

You may exercise your rights under Articles 7, 8, 9 and 10 of Legislative Decree no. 196 of 30 June 2003, by contacting the Data Controller at our head office on + 39 02 72434255, or by sending an e-mail to the following address: privacy@triennale.it. At any time, you have the right to obtain confirmation of the existence or non-existence of your personal data and to know the content and origin, verify the accuracy or request integration, updating or amendment (Article 7 of the Personal Data Protection Code). In compliance with the same Article, you are entitled to request the cancellation, transfer to anonymous form or blockage of any unlawfully processed data. You also have the right to refuse processing on legitimate grounds.
